Tickets and seating

- For safety and fire-regulation reasons, hall seating is limited and children age two and under are welcome to sit on a parent's lap. Older children who are not pupils at JYS will require their own seat and ticket.
- Initial ticket allocation: up to 2 tickets per family for Thursday and Friday performances.
- For the Wednesday 8 July performance, Year 6 families may purchase up to 4 tickets per family for this performance. Year 6 families may also purchase 2 additional tickets to use on either of the other performance days.
