Summary of School Development Priorities 2017 - 2018

Priority 1: Leadership and Management

- 1. Leaders at all levels are focused on monitoring, evaluating the impact and reviewing the key priorities contained in this plan so that interim and final targets are met.
- 2. There will be clear evidence of the impact of Sports Premium spending.

Priority 2: Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- 1. To develop pedagogy that will accelerate the progress of children in vulnerable groups enabling them to overcome barriers to learning so that gaps in rates of progress and attainment close.
- 2. Increase the numbers of children working at greater depth in writing and maths by the end of keystage 2 by accelerating progress for higher achieving pupils across the school

Priority 3: Behaviour, Welfare and Safety

- 1. Develop the quality of PSHE across the school with an explicit focus on SMSC and British Values and identifying opportunities for developing multi-cultural learning and links.
- 2. Embed a Growth Mindset approach to support all children to achieve to their full potential as successful learners

Priority 4: Outcomes

- 1. Further accelerate rates of progress for vulnerable groups and focus children across every keystage so that each child's attainment further improves and comparative gaps are narrowed.
- 2. Increase the numbers of children across the school on track to achieve 'greater depth' in writing and maths.

Priority 5: Early Years

- 1. To embed aspects of the excellent practise established over the last two years in Year 1 and keystage 1.
- 2. Develop approaches to phonic intervention to support vulnerable learners at the earliest possible stage.
